





A clock that has an hour hand and a minute hand.




Digital clock

A clock that uses only <u>numbers</u> to show time.



Hour Hand


The hand on a clock that tells the hour. It is the shorter hand.





Minute Hand


The <u>longer hand</u> on a clock that tells the <u>minutes.</u>


